George : Where did you buy it?

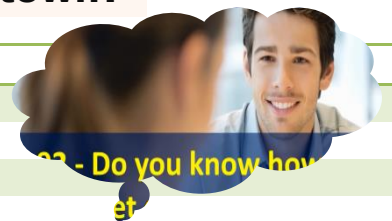
Sharon : At Wal-Mart.

Frank : Did you watch the game last night?

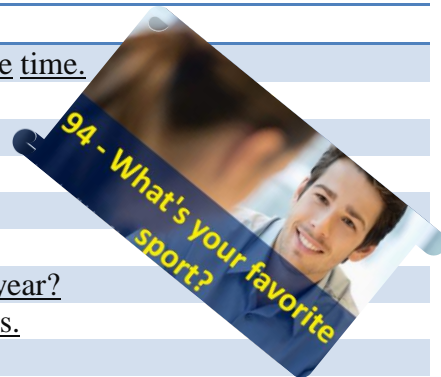
Stephanie : A little, not the whole thing. I watched the second half though and I saw some of the highlights online.

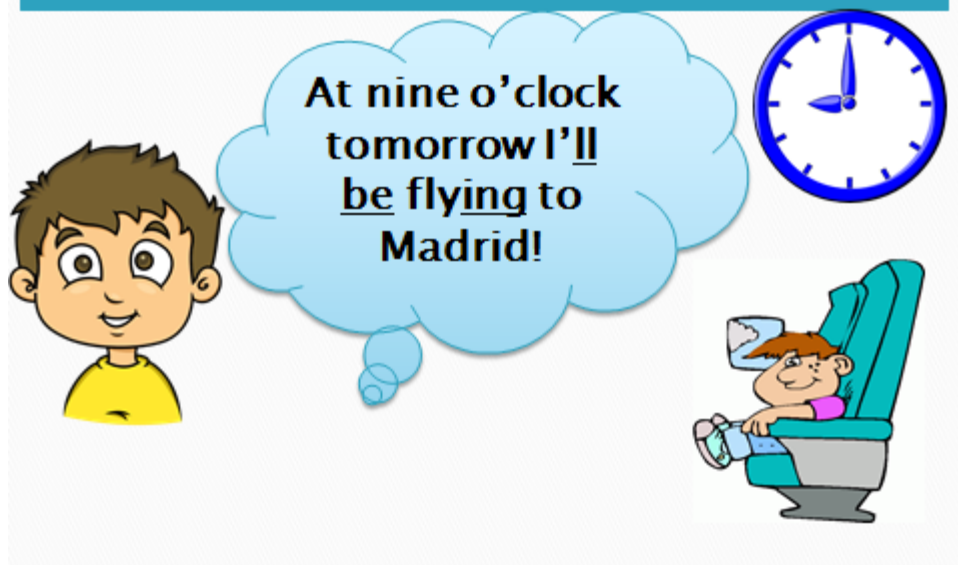
